TOPIC: Development and Implementation of a No Wrong Door System
for Accessing Long Term Services and Supports

What does it mean to have a No Wrong Door (NWD) System in Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS) for all populations and all payers? What is the national vision across the Administration for Community Living (ACL), the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services & and Veterans Health Administration for a NWD system and what opportunity does it present to states? This presentation will describe how the NWD system is currently being defined and implemented. Topics to be covered include: specific functions within a NWD System, national roll-out of person-centered counseling; development of a NWD management tool; and state progress in getting reimbursed for NWD functions.

Joseph Lugo is the director of the national No Wrong Door/Aging and Disability Resource Center initiative at ACL. Joseph joined AoA in 2005 and currently serves as the team lead within the Office Integrated Programs, which oversees efforts such as Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC), Care Transitions, and the Veterans Directed and Home and Community Based Services Program. Prior to joining ACL, Joseph led Illinois' ADRC initiative and Illinois' implementation of the National Family Caregiver Support Program, and oversaw the aged/disabled Medicaid waiver program.
